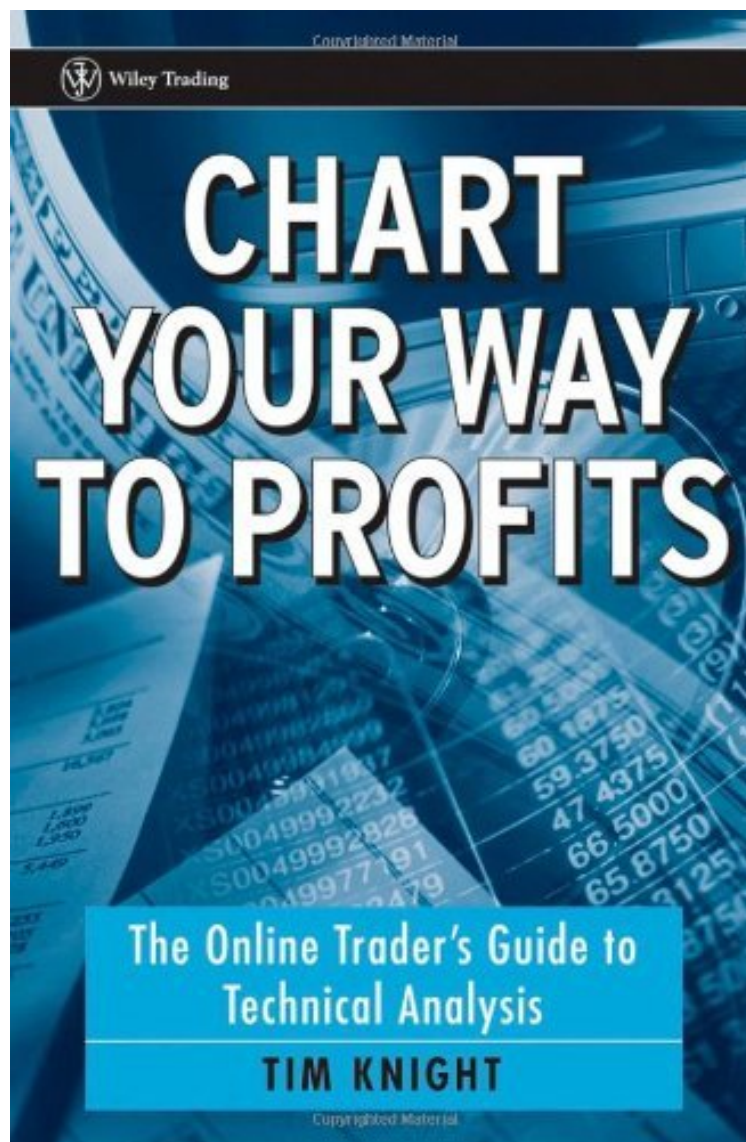

treatment of the subject. I own many books on technical analysis, and this is the most direct and understandable of any that I have read (or attempted to read). Probably better suited for the beginner to intermediate investor wanting to better understand the field than the advanced technician. The book is very applied but has enough theory to provide context. While it is accurate that the author cites examples using web sites that he has an affiliation with, the concepts are readily transferable to any number of technical analysis web sites or software programs--they all have most of the same functionality. Besides, the meat of the book concerns describing and interpreting chart patterns.
