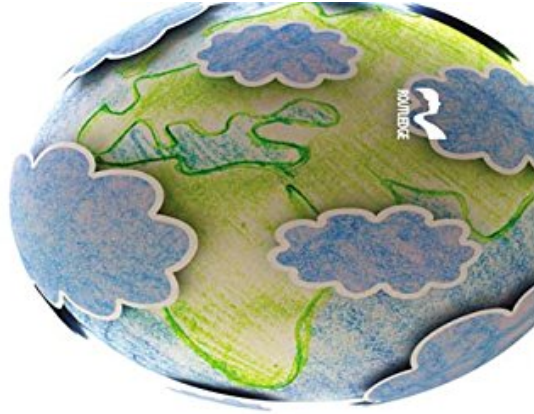

This version (french edition) is almost the same except it has one outstanding improvement. It uses IPA symbols to help you pronounce the words. This is the reason it gets 5 stars for me. Now the words are pronounced the same way they are in a french dictionary. Of course, it's a little difficult at first to learn and understand the IPA symbols. Frankly, I am not very satisfied with it. I don't like the exercises. I prefer what I call substitution drills: elle parle francce dil; ais (nous): nous parlons francce dil; ais (russe): nous parlons russe. I don't think the exercises in this book give students sufficient practice with the language. Also, the explanations are wordy. I just obtained a certificate in Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL), and the "in" teaching method, community

language approach, prefers demonstrating grammar rather than lengthy explanations. I think it sticks better that way. I redid the section on countries and how to say I am in or going to [specific country]. I put the masculine countries on one side and the feminine on the other and below wrote: je suis au Canada, je vais au Japon. Je suis en Angleterre, je vais en Espagne. Less fuss and clearer. By Dvayne59 It is the number of errors in this book that I find so frustrating! It seems obvious that no one took the time to proofread it. I picked up this book to do some french revision and by the time I got up to lesson 8, was ready to throw it in the trash. Accent marks are used only sporadically (sometimes ecrire, sometimes eacute;crire...) They especially seem to have problems with "la rue Whitehall". In the french text, It appears as "la Whitehall street"! The pluralization errors have been irritating, too. If this is intended to teach a beginning student proper French, I feel it will do nothing but confuse him/her. I do NOT recommend this book.
