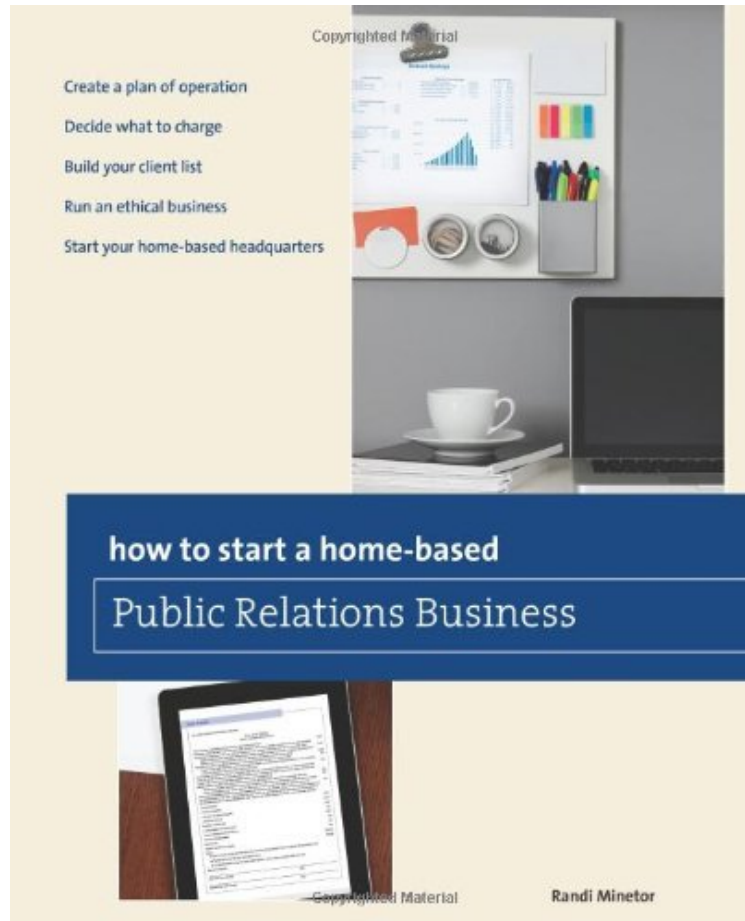


# How to Start a Home-based Public Relations Business (Home-Based Business Series)
