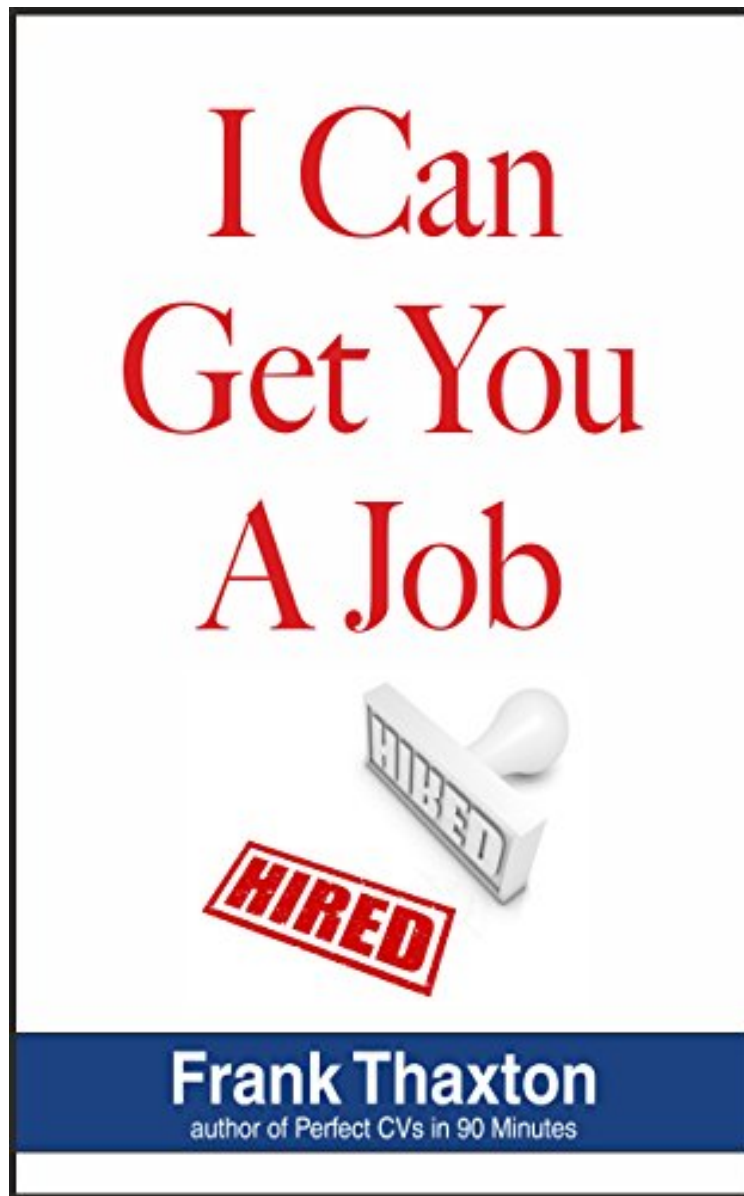

I know about this. For those out there in that position looking for and getting a new job, this is THE book to have. Why do I say that? It is because this

is the book that not only gives sensible advice for your job search, but, and as far as I am concerned uniquely, it deals with your feelings as you go about the long hard slog of getting a new job. You will get a new job; you will like it and you will look back at your old job thinking, "why did I not move sooner". But until you are in that 'place', this book is for you. Chapters on practical help are followed by chapters on your psychological effect of your job search. BTW the piece on "networking" and the informal job market is particularly helpful. As you gather I rate this book highly. It is not a book with 200 CVs, or application letters to copy, but one assisting the applicant in the totality of the job search: nothing more, nothing less.
